YEAR 13 Information – please note the following information only applies for students in Year 13

Dear Student and Parent/Carer,

Please rest assured that all steps taken at this time in relation to Covid-19 are to ensure the utmost safety for your child in line with local authority and Welsh Government guidance.

The current COVID-19 situation continues to develop, and in recognition of this will continue to develop our educational provision in line with the best advice we have at this time.

In addition to the modifications set out in my previous letter, further changes are set out below and will be in place from Monday 14th September.

Year 13 students;

- Can be excused from attending registration if their first lesson of the day is after break
- Are not required to attend school if they have no lessons during a school day.

Whilst being appreciative of the information within this letter, we want to stress the importance of the next few months for Year 13 pupils as they prepare to apply to the universities of their choice. Where possible, we will continue to encourage our students to attend their registration periods which provide mentoring and guidance on how to best complete this process.

Where students use school transport, and arrive at school at the start of the day, they will be expected to attend morning registration. For those students that will need to remain in school all day due to transport needs will have access to our high quality sixth form facilities and café area.

To ensure the safeguarding of our students, it is imperative that they sign in and out every day when they arrive and leave using our Sixth Form safeguarding iPad system.

We will always strive to ensure that we are doing what is right for our students and the above modifications are temporary changes in the current climate. Our long term goal will be to resume normal school protocols when it is appropriate to do so.
